

SURVEY REPORT ON ALUMNI, TEACHERS AND STUDENTS, 2021 AND ACTION TAKEN

Three surveys are conducted in Govt. Degree College, Kanchanpur, North Tripura in the year 2021 from teachers, students and alumni of the College. Following are short report of the surveys conducted. Survey for all the three categories are conducted in online Google Form.

Alumni Survey: There are 13 questions posed to the respondents in where alumni are asked about their address, contact no, name, present status, about finding job, relevance of their course in college to their present job, role of college in job preparation, about their visits and experience of college, how willing they are to participate in alumni's activity and if they have any suggestion. Majority of the respondents feel that it is difficult to get a job but all the respondents feel that College has prepared them in finding a job. Majority of the respondents visited the college and attended some events held in the college. More than half of the respondents are willing to actively participate in alumni events. Majority of the respondents are likely to recommend the College to others. Valuable suggestions are offered by the respondents and majority of the respondents have a very good experience during their days in college.

Teachers' survey: In teachers' survey, 20 questions were put forward where the respondents answered all the questions. The questions deal with experience, designation, qualification, relationship with co-workers, sense of ownership, mutual respect, maintenance of college property, balance between academics ,sports and extra-curricular activities, freedom to try new methods, consultation before decision making, credit for one's work, satisfaction with pay, involvement of parents in their wards education, benefit of online teaching, whether they will recommend the institution and lastly, whether they are happy with their present job. Overall, good response is received from all concerned.

Students' survey: Altogether 315 students responded to the questions put before them. Majority of the respondents opined that syllabus is challenging and give Good rating to their course. Regarding library holding of the course, less than half of the respondents give Excellent, but majority feels that library staffs are helpful. Half of the respondents feel that teacher student relationship is good and 35.2% feel it is very good. Half of the students rated health care facilities in the college Good. Almost half of the students participate in extra-curricular activities. Regarding relevance of internal assessment, half of the respondents are satisfied, and half of them find the academic content of the syllabus as good. On an average, around half of the respondents visit the college library regularly. Majority of the respondents feel that the office staffs are helpful and that grievance are redressed when put in a box. Almost everyone responded that there are enough clean classrooms in the college and majority opined that toilets are cleaned properly. Half of the respondents are happy with the food served in canteen and majority opined there is enough drinking water provided to them. Majority of the respondents avail scholarship from the Government.

Action Taken: After survey is collected from all concerned, they are analyzed carefully keeping in mind the welfare of all concerned and overall development of the college. Improvement plan is formulated whenever necessity is felt for the same.
